## Organization and selection of the steering committee of epigraphy.info Jonas Osnabrügge, Heidelberg

## Key points:

- composition - 7 people from the community
- responsibilities:
- representation of the community to the public, acting as a point of contact for interested parties
- organizing, facilitating and keeping track of the community efforts to make sure that redundancies are avoided, the mission statement is adhered to if possible and all voices are heard
- organizing the decision-making processes of the community
- staying in contact until the next meeting
- not a dictatorial board of people who make the decisions for the community :)
- Three core areas of responsibilities (groups of ,stakeholders')
- each ideally represented by two members of the committee, plus one as organizer for the next meeting
technical (backend) side
- people experienced in the issues of technical realization
- coordination between people or groups working on the technical side of the project
user side
- user profiles/use cases/usability
- people ideally without too much technical experience (there should be a balance here)
- community outreach (e.g. in the context of EpiDoc-training workshops)
organizational side
- vision/coordination/financing
- keeping track of tasks and their implementation
- issues of a possible editorial board
- mission statement
- organization and coordination of the next meeting
- record-keeping/minutes


## - (s)election process

- term: one year
- maximum of two consecutive terms
- this means that the members of the committee that have been active since the Heidelberg meeting (F. Feraudi, J. Lougovaya, A. Kurilic) will be up for election at Vienna
- resignations in the intermediate time should be filled during the next meeting
- election by all present at the workshop at the end of the workshop
- election from all present at the workshop
- everyone can nominate herself or nominate/second the nomination of someone else
- voting by secret electronic ballot
- if the number of candidates is less than or equal to the number of seats all nominated are elected automatically and no election is held
